## **Bloom Session 10**

The Bloom Reader is an Android app which

- Displays Bloom books
- Plays Talking Books recorded in Bloom

**Bloom Desktop** is enhanced with a "Publish to Bloom Reader" function that can push Bloom books directly to a connected Android device for immediate use during and after book-making workshops.

In this session we will learn how to put Bloom Books into the Bloom Reader app on Android.

## Setup

Download and install Bloom Reader on your Android app via the Google Play Store.

Start Bloom.

Start Bloom Reader.

### **Choose a Collection**

1. The main window appears. Click **Other Collections**.

The **Open/Create Collection** dialog box appears.

2. Select the desired collection.

The main window reappears.

#### Move a book to Bloom Reader

- 1. Select the desired book in the collection by clicking on it.
- 2. Click Edit this book.
- 3. Change the page size and orientation to **Device16x9Portrait**.
- 4. Check each page to verify that they display on the screen properly. If not, make any adjustments necessary to the problem pages.
- 5. Connect your Android device to your PC via cable or Wi-Fi.
- 6. Click the **Publish** icon.
- 7. Select **Android**. Verify Bloom Reader is running on your Android device.
- 8. If desired, select color from **Thumbnail Color**
- 9. Select your choice from **Method Choices**.
- 10. After sending is completed. On your Android, play the sent book.
- 11. Sometimes not all the text will be displayed on the Android. You may need to make some adjustments in the Bloom book to get all the text to fit.
- 12. Note the Bloom Reader can also handle talking books.
