Bloom Session 11

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Introduction

There are other more advanced features of Bloom that have not been covered in this course. Some of them could be cover in this session. Below is a list of potential features with a brief explanation that may be covered in this session.

List of potential features

- 1. **Custom Page**: Bloom allows the user to setup a custom page. The user can define how many text frames and image frames can be on a page and their location on the page. See video on custom page. A good exercise is to have the participants create an alphabet chart using the custom page feature.
- 2. **Topic on Front Cover**: The user can choose a topic to be displayed on the right bottom corner of the front cover. Just click on **Click to choose topic** on the front cover page.
- 3. **Textbox to an image**: One way to add a caption to a picture is to use the "Add a text box to image" feature. Right-click on the picture and select Add Text Box to Image. It will create text box that you add text to and that you move to a particular location within the picture.
- 4. **Create a new Style**: The user can create a new style that is different from one of the default styles. In the text box, click on the Gear icon. In the **Style Name** tab of the Format dialog box, click on **Create a new style**. Give the new style a new name and select the base style. Then you can make whatever changes you want to the new style.
- 5. **Text Box Properties**: There is a Change Layout control that allows you choose text box properties. These properties include languages, vertical alignment of word, borders and background. Set the **change layout** icon for the text box. The click the Gear icon in the center of the text box. The **Text Box Properties** dialog box appears. Make whatever changes you would like.
- 6. **Unlock a Shell Book**: The **locked** button at the bottom of the **Pages** pane tells you that book is in translated only mode. Click the **locked** button. Now the user can add, duplicate and remove pages. The **Change Layout** control is now available for use. The **Format** dialog box allows more format changes.
- 7. **Logo on Title Page**: To use this feature, you must choose an organization (e.g. SIL-International) in the **Bloom Enterprise Project** textbox in the **Settings** dialog box. Then the logo for that organization will appear on the title page or on some other designated page.
- 8. **Template Starter**: In the left pane of the **Collections** tab, the Template Starter is one of the available templates. When you click it, the right pane displays how to use the Template Starter. Template Starter is a template you can use to provide a set of related page layouts that a user can choose while authoring an original book.
