Keyman has free versions for Windows, MacOS, Linux, iOS (iPhone and iPad), Android and web (a Keyman keyboard can be put on a website so users can use it without installing Keyman). Keyman lists over 1000 languages with keyboards available: <http://keyman.com/>^[1].
