

# Keyboards for Indic Languages

*What's the best keyboard for Devanagari script? Or specifically for Nepali?*

We won't list InKey keyboards<sup>[1]</sup> here, as no further development is happening with InKey, but if you're waiting on a Keyman keyboard to be developed for an Indic script not listed here, check out the options available at [inkeysoftware.com](http://inkeysoftware.com)<sup>[2]</sup>. -Just don't expect to get support from the developer.
