Keyman: Malayalam Winscript (NLCI)

This Keyboard mimics the Malayalam WinScript Keyboard Layout designed by NLCI in 1988. This is a phonetic based keyboarding system designed with the objective of keyboarding text with minimal keystrokes. Keys are also layed out according the frequency of occurance, yet mostly follow a phonetic-based keyboarding system.
