## To convert a Word document to Wiki

When you copy and paste from Word you get a lot of unnecessary formatting code. It is easier to do it from OpenOffice.

```
ta charset="utf-8" />
```

Best way is to use Open Office<sup>[1]</sup>

1. Open the Word document in Open Office<sup>[2]</sup> Writer.
2. Go to File / Export.
3. Under File format choose MediaWiki (.txt).
4. Click Save (or Export).
5. Open the new file in a text editor and copy the contents to the clipboard.
6. Paste the text to a Wikipedia article.
