FLEx 8

FLEx (FieldWorks Language Explorer) is a program to help language teams manage language and cultural data. FLEx is designed specifically to help linguists build a dictionary and develop their understanding of the grammar, as they use it to analyse and interlinearize texts. This training plan (course) is based upon version 8. It is best to start with the Introduction and follow its recommended teaching order.

Note: This course also works for FLEx 9
