## Course Instructor Computer Setup

## Description

- As an instructor, it is important to have your computer setup so that is easy to see from a distance when projected in the classroom.
- If you are going to teach a Paratext Course, I recommend following the steps described here to setup your computer for teaching.
- Here are some suggestions to make that happen. These should work for **Windows Vista**, **Windows 7**, and **Windows 8**.

## Increase Screen Magnification

- 1. Go to the Control Panel.
- 2. In the *upper-right*, search for *display*.
- 3. Click on Make text and other items larger or smaller.
- 4. Choose 150%.
- 5. Click Apply.
- 6. Logoff your computer.
- 7. **Logon** to your computer.
- 8. Test these settings on the **projector** you will be using, in the **room** you will be teaching.
- 9. If the text is too large from the back of the room, try 125%.

## Increase Mouse Pointer Size

- 1. Go to the Control Panel.
- 2. In the *upper-right*, search for *mouse*.
- 3. Click on Change how the mouse pointer looks.
- 4. In the **Scheme drop-down**, choose the **Windows Standard (Extra Large)** option.
  - a. To avoid confusion, it is best to use a **Standard** scheme rather than **Aero**, **Black**, or **Inverted**.
- 5. Click Apply.
